- Lunch will also be provided after the service for all students every Sunday in October - we'd love to meet you!

Accountability

If you would like to chat to and be accountable to an older Christian one2one on a semi-regular basis, then sign up. We are told to 'encourage each other, as long as it is called today.' (Hebrews 3) There are times when we all need encouragement and wisdom from someone who's been through it all before.

CU

We would encourage you to get involved with the Christian Union. The work of the CU may be the first experience some non-Christian students have of Jesus.
